It holds a high diversity of habitats and species in a confined space, which in part have a human influence since ancient times.

Restoration of the Pas d'en Revull has been carried out with the aim of recovering the ancient dry stone wall structures that delimit and protect this area, using the traditional techniques of dry stone wall building. Different social groups and volunteers from the municipality of Ferreries, who are concerned about the conservation of this unique pathway, have participated actively in the works of clearing and restoration. A botanic route will be developed in order to raise awareness of the ecological and botanical values of the area.
